

Narrow-leaved Peppermint Eucalyptus radiata

Hardy, well-structured drought-tolerant tree that is locally native and contributes to local character. Creamy white flowers in summer attract birds and insects. Oil produced by this Eucalypt is used in essential oil production.

Features:

- Dark green leaves that have a peppermint scent when crushed
- Finely-fissured bark



Common Horse Chestnut Aesculus hippocastanum

Medium, oval, fast-growing deciduous tree with distinctive foliage and a great shade tree. Leaves exhibit different shades of yellow-brown in Autumn.

Features:

- Small, white flowers cover the tree in spring
- Chestnut-like fruit
