

Judas Tree Cercis silquastrum

Small deciduous feature tree with rounded heartshaped leaves. Produces a striking display in spring with clusters of pink -purplish flowers.

Features:

- Brilliant spring colour
- Elegant, mulit-branched form



Wilga *Geijera parviflora*

A small evergreen tree with attractive drooping foliage which has a strong scent when crushed. The flowers appearing in winter to spring are cream and musky scented.

Features:

- Glossy dark green leaves and drooping branches
- Small white flowers in loose panicles in winter to spring and spherical fruit containing a shiny black seed
