Option 1



Claret Ash

Fraxinus oxycarpa 'Raywoodii'

A well-structured deciduous specimen tree, good for summer shade. Deep green, narrow leaves turn maroon in Autumn.

Features:

- Stunning autumn colour
- Drought-tolerant

Option 2



Yellow Box

Eucalyptus melliodora

A well-structured native tree with small leaves, locally native to the area. Produces fragrant, white flowers and is used widely for honey production.

Features:

- Unusual, sometimes twisting bark featuring grey, yellow, red and brown colours
- Favoured food tree of the critically endangered Swift Parrot, which moves through the north of Melbourne in Autumn and Winter on its annual migration from Tasmania
