Red Oak *Ouercus rubra*

A fast-growing, well- structured tree with attractive red to golden brown foliage in Autumn. Small, insignificant flowers appear in spring.

Features:

- Broad habit, glossy dark green leaves that turn red in Autumn before falling
- Grows straight and tall with a rounded top at maturity



Blueberry Ash Elaeocarpus reticulatus

Small, hardy native tree with dark green foliage and dark blue berries.

Features:

- Reddish-pink young leaves
- White feathery flowers in spring and summer
