Understanding the new Community Local Law

The Community Local Law 2024 is designed to balance safety, personal freedom, and community responsibility, ensuring the City of Whittlesea remains a welcoming 'A Place For All'. It covers a wide range of areas including rubbish bins, animals, and the upkeep of public spaces to enhance community safety and neighbourhood amenities.

Important changes for residents

- Maintenance of buildings and houses: maintain your property to ensure it is maintained and in good condition
- Building sites: where construction or building works stop, ensure
 the site is secured with safety fencing and cannot be accessed
 by the public

 Fire/flood damaged properties: secure the site so the public cannot access.

What this means for you

- Plan ahead: understand how the new Local Laws affect you to ensure you are ready by the 1 July 2024 deadline
- Community responsibility: these changes were driven by community feedback and aim to improve safety, protect public spaces, and enhance the quality of our neighbourhoods
