Each year Council undertakes the Street Tree Renewal Program to ensure that trees throughout the municipality are of a high standard and that the types of trees planted add character and appeal to the area.

Please let us know which species you would prefer planted. Tree options for your street are listed below.

Option 1



Firewheel Tree

Stenocarpus sinuatus

A native shade tree with ornamental red circular flowers in summer.

Features:

- Medium to large upright ornamental native tree
- Red wheel shaped flowers from late summer to early winter and dark glossy deeply lobed leaves all year-round.

Option 2



Kurrajong

Brachychiton populneus

This tree is short and stout with interesting greenish bark. It is a dense, broad domed tree that offers great shade. It can become semi-deciduous in early summer.

Features:

- Cream to pale green bell shaped flowers appearing October to December with pale pink to purple flecks
- Large leaves of varying shapes
