Red Maple

Acer Freemanii 'cultivar'

Large, domed deciduous tree with fantastic red Autumn foliage and a great shade tree. It has a brilliant, red-orange colour in winter.

Features:

- Green, deeply lobed leaves turn an intense red in Autumn
- Great shade tree, ideal for streets and avenues.



Wilga

Geijera Parviflora

A slow growing small tree with attractive pendulous foliage which have a strong scent when crushed. The winter to spring flowers are cream and musky scented.

Features:

- Glossy dark green leaves and drooping branches
- Small white flowers in loose paniclesin winter to spring and spherical fruit containing a shiny black seed.
