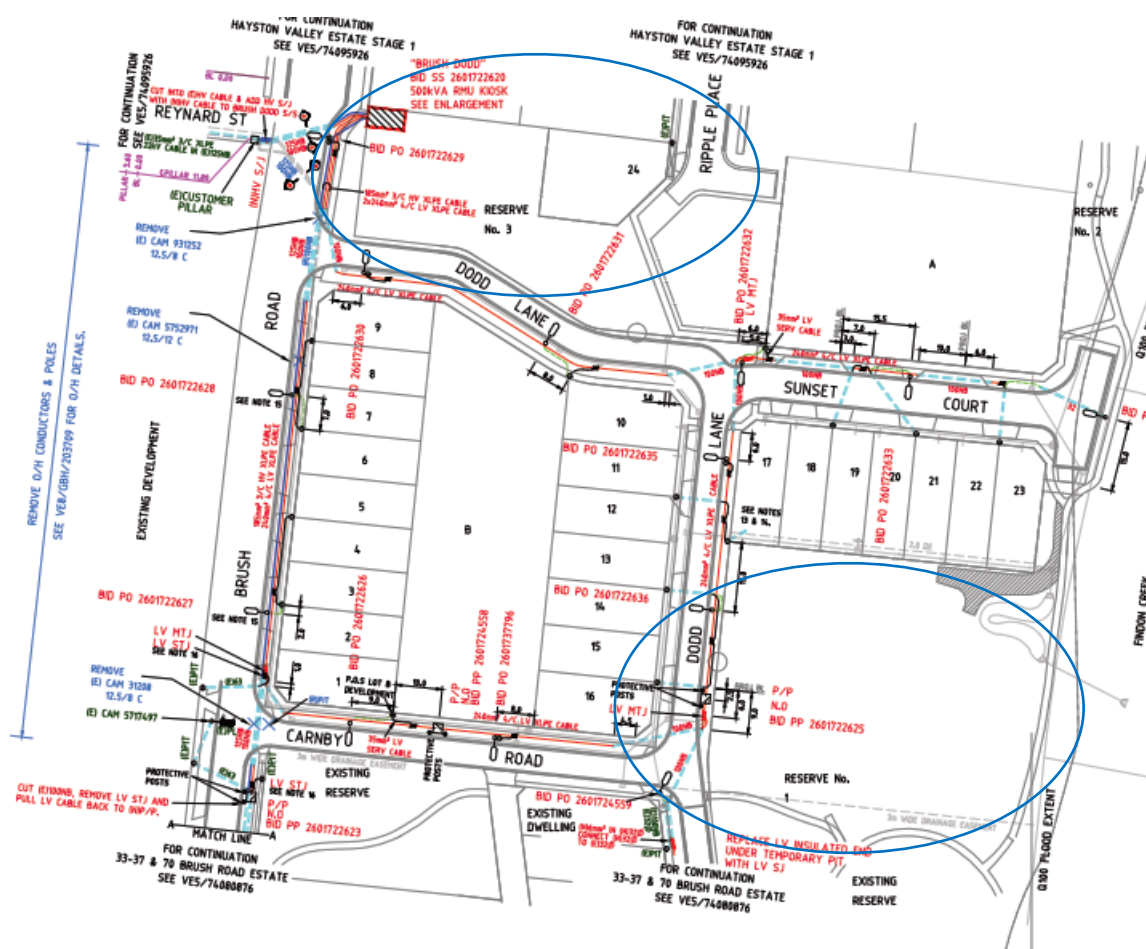
1. Proposed Name
